

HISTORY

Lincoln Park's namesake park is one of Chicago's most frequently

used parks, with 20 million visitors a year. In addition to lakefront access, ponds, and walking paths, Lincoln Park is also home to some of Chicago's most famous museums. One of the city's first public museums and the model for the Chicago Park District's museum-in-the-park program, The Chicago Academy of Arts and Sciences, moved into the park in 1898. They relocated in 1999 and the museum is now called the Peggy Notebaert Nature Museum. The Lincoln Park Conservatory was completed in 1895 and is described as "paradise under glass" showcasing exotic plants in their four display houses. The Chicago History Museum opened in the park in 1932 and is home to over 22 million artifacts, exhibits and interactive programming.

The Lincoln Park Zoo started off small with the gift of two swans and then the purchase of a bear cub for \$10 in 1874.

Lincoln Park Zoo is now home to more than 1,100 animals and is one of the last free zoos in the country.

WHAT TO DO?

- Catch a show at **Steppenwolf Theatre's** sprawling campus on N. Halsted featuring four theaters and two lobby bars.
- Warm up with fondue at **Geja's Café** which opened as Chicago's first wine bar in 1965.
- Head to **Armitage** and **Halsted** for a day of shopping while enjoying the historic Victorian-era architecture.
- Enjoy gorgeous lakeside and skyline views while dining at The **Lakefront Restaurant** located at Chicago's historic **Theater on the Lake**.

LAKEFRONT-CLARK

ARMITAGE — HALSTED

In addition to being one of Chicago's most famous shopping districts and home to the **Old Town School of Folk Music's** home on Armitage, this is also known as Lincoln Park's unofficial wine district anchored by **J9 Wine Bar**, **Summer House Santa Monica** and **Birch Road Cellar**, Lincoln Park's private wine club.

LINCOLN — HALSTED

Lincoln Avenue is one of Chicago's famed diagonal streets and features renowned local theaters and iconic music venues anchored by **DePaul University's School of Music**, **Theatre School at DePaul**, and the **DePaul Art Museum** as well as **Lincoln Common**.

NORTH — CLYBOURN

From local gems to national retailers, the North —Clybourn area features the acclaimed **Steppenwolf Theatre** and **NEWCITY** complex.

GETTING THERE

BY CAR

Lincoln Park is easily accessed from the **Kennedy Expressway** with exits at **Diversey**, **Fullerton**, **Damen**, **Armitage**, and **North** as well as **Lake Shore Drive** with exits at **Fullerton** and **North Ave**.

BY BIKE

The **Lakefront Trail**, which runs from **Rogers Park** to **Hyde Park**, provides car-free biking across the length of the city with Lincoln Park exits at **Diversey Harbor**, **W. Fullerton**, and **W. LaSalle**.

BY TRAIN

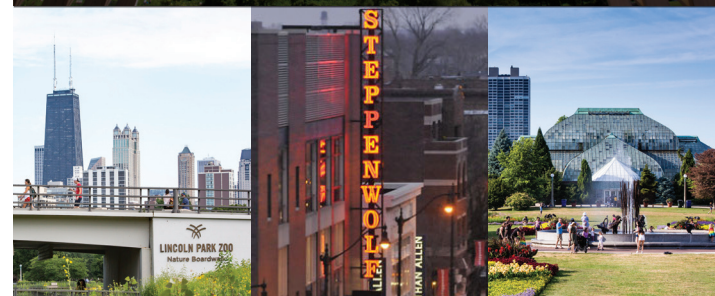
Lincoln Park is serviced by three CTA lines: the **Brown**, **Red**, and **Purple Lines**.
